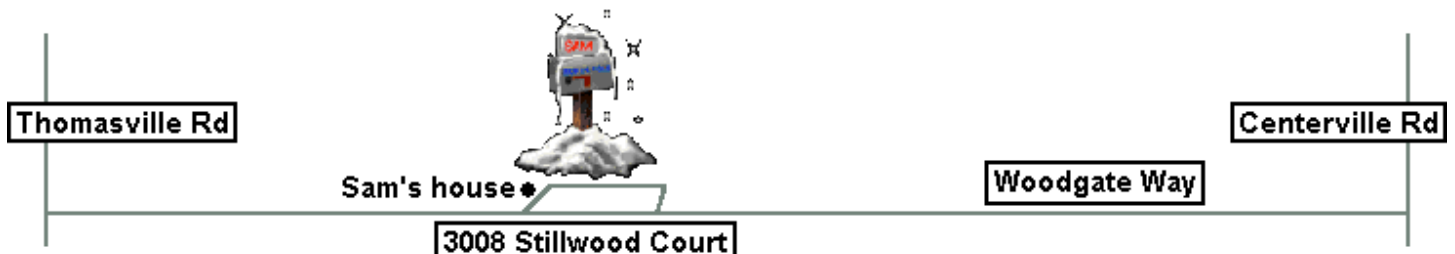
Season's Greetings
