




Veteran's Memorial Railroad - 14043 NW CR 12, Bristol

Drive west on I-10 to SR 12 exit (approx Mile Marker 174) and go left through Greensboro to Bristol on SR 12; at junction of SR 12 and SR 20 in Bristol turn right

At stoplight turn left on to County Road 12 and go about 1/4 mile to Theo Jacobs on left; Theo Jacobs is paved and on the north side of the Civic Center

Continue on Theo Jacobs past the new station and full size caboose and turn right on dirt road at the Veterans Memorial Railroad sign Follow the dirt road straight ahead past the playgound, restroom and picnic shelter to the small blue station building. The train will probably be out at the station and plainly visible.
