Set-Up - Friday: set-up begins at 2 pm and runs to 5 pm.

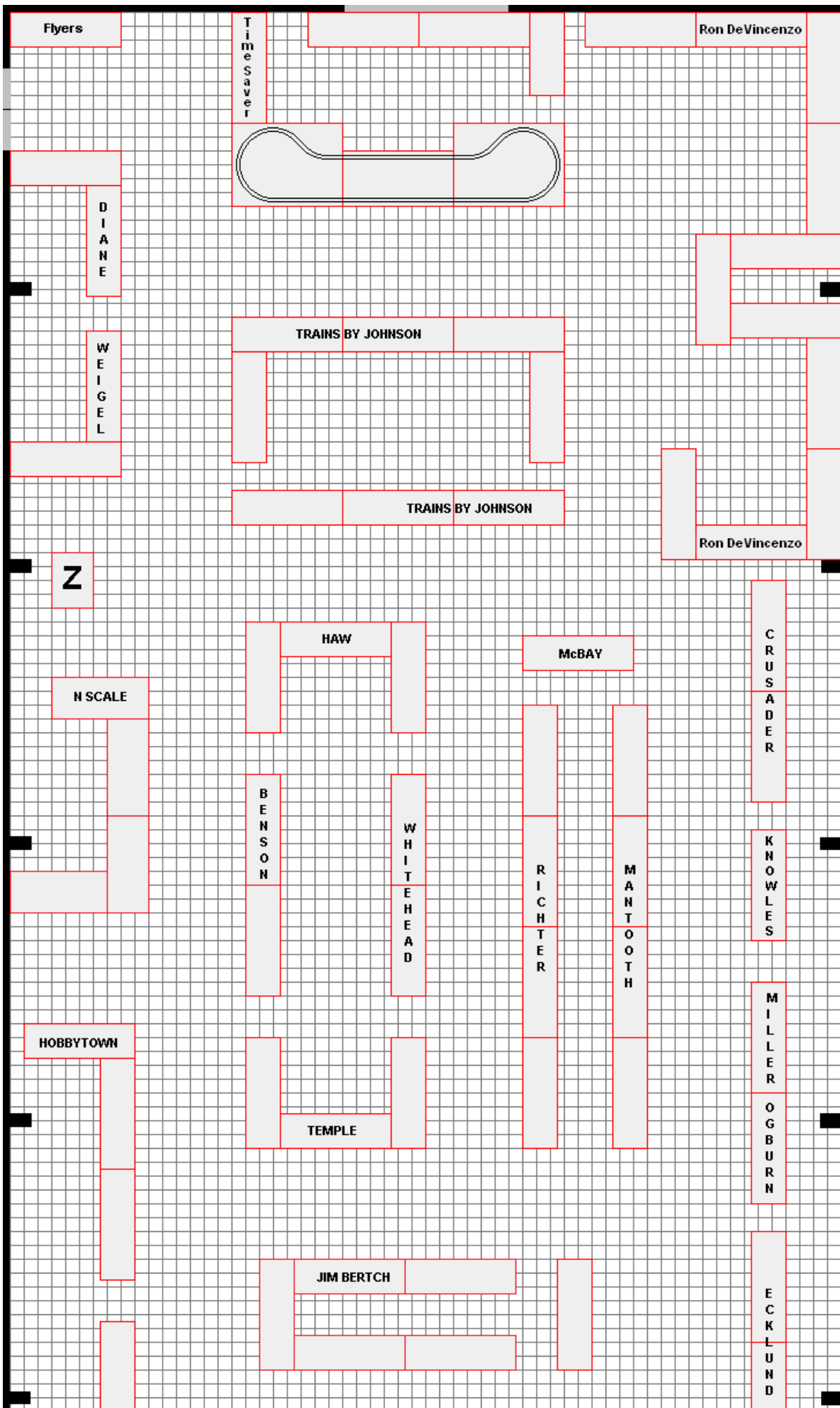

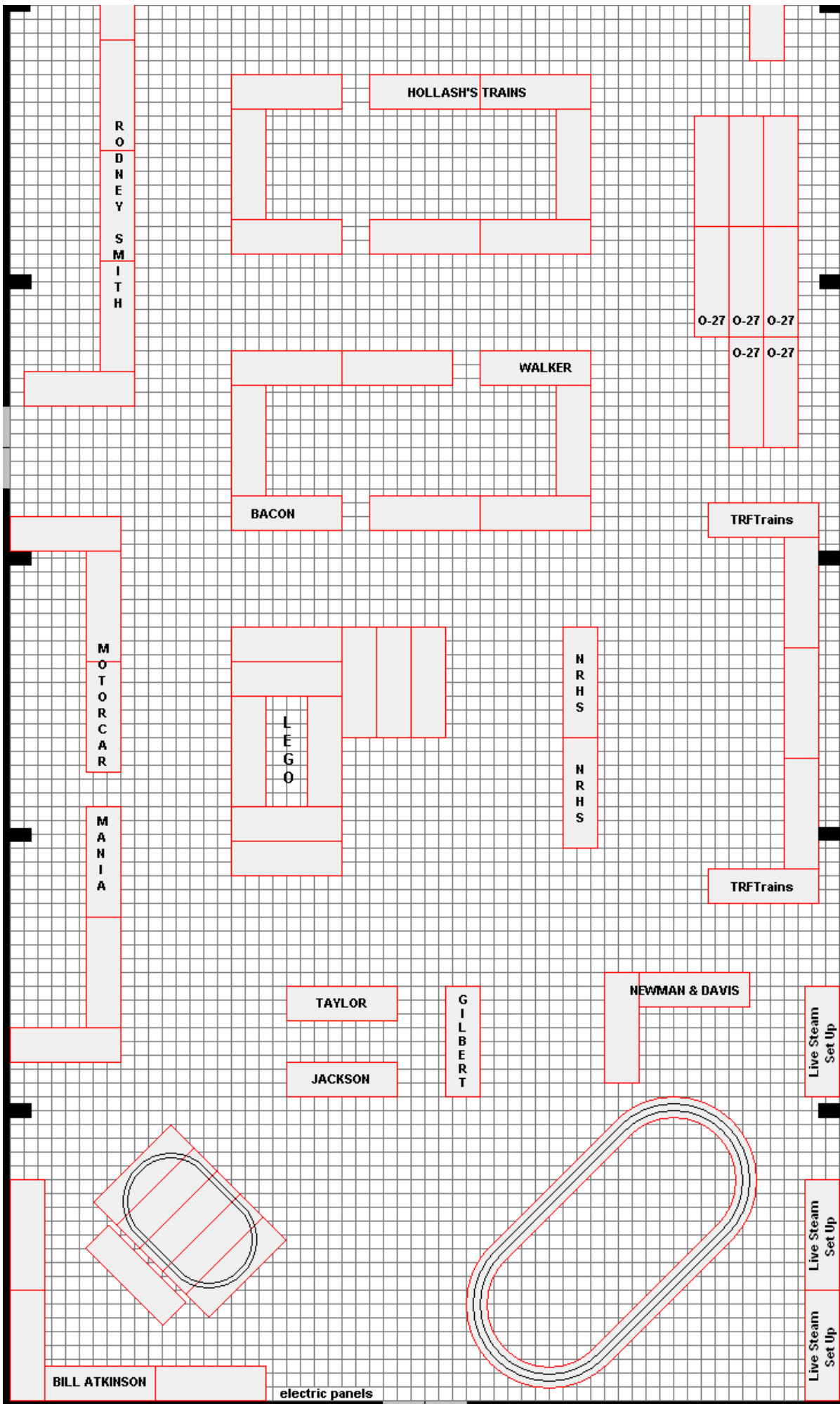

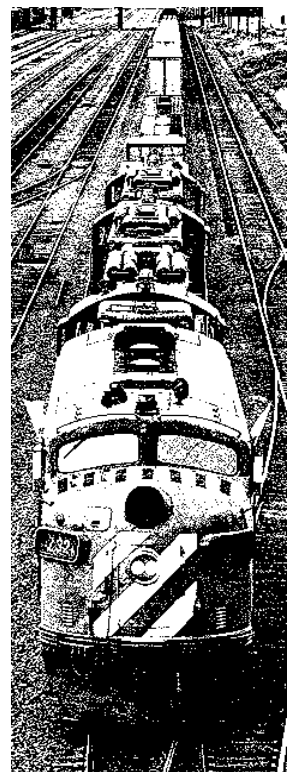
